Learning to cut glass with confidence.

As a student, you will learn how to handle and cut glass with confidence. You will learn the basics of fusing ie glass compatibility, colour combination and how to add detail.

You will have the opportunity to design and fuse a piece of glass, this could be a bowl, panel, or a set of coasters for example. The final piece will be fired in the kiln overnight ready for collection the following day.

You may want your piece slumped into a mold (bowl, dish) this will take an additional 24 hrs.

Foiling techniques

Soldering techniques

Cleaning, attaching findings and hangers

As a student, you will learn how to handle and cut glass with confidence. Using these skills you will then have the opportunity to create a small practice piece using 3mm clear glass. You will then assemble this piece using the copper foiling method.

Finally learning how to solder the glass together, creating smooth lines.

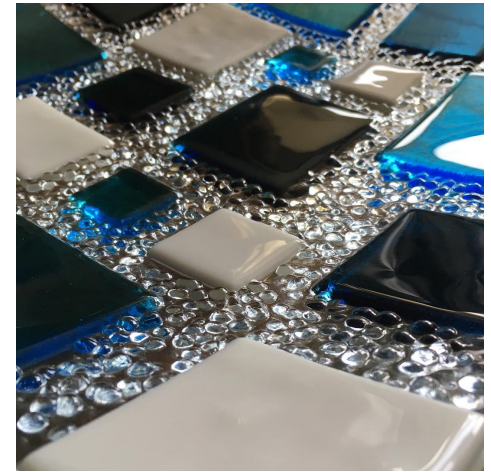


With 3 kilns for use/hire, there is ample room for projects both large and small.
